

# LEADERSHIP GREATER VALLEY 2025 COURSE OUTLINE\*

## SESSION 1) QUALITIES OF LEADERSHIP - Thursday, September 18th - 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm

At the core of many current leadership models is the concept of change – how to foster and manage it. This hands-on workshop presents models and practices associated with establishing an innovative environment and specific leadership tools to maximize performance levels and the ability to operate as change leaders.

# SESSION 2) HISTORY OF THE VALLEY - Thursday, September 25<sup>th</sup> - 12:00 noon - 5:00 pm

To understand where we are going, we must first learn where we have been. This session will open your eyes to the reasons why the Valley has played a key role in manufacturing in the United States and how important leaders in our Country's founding were linked to some of the towns in the Valley.

## SESSION 3) GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC SERVICE – Thursday, October 9th – 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm

This session will explore the roles and responsibilities of our elected & appointed officials and will engage participants in a discussion on the important issues that are shaping the future of our communities.

# SESSION 4) MEDIA & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT – Thursday, October 16<sup>th</sup> – 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm

A 2011 report by the Federal Communications Commission found that local newspapers are the best medium to provide the sort of public service journalism that shines a light on the major issues confronting communities and gives residents the information they need to solve their problems. How have things changed since that study. This session will explore the various aspects of today's media and its impact on yourself and the community.

#### SESSION 5) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND THE REGION – Thursday, October 23rd – 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm

What are the forces driving the region's economy? In this session, participants will interact with a diverse mix of private and public sector leaders that are shaping the Valley's economy for the 21st century.

#### SESSION 6) HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES - Thursday, October 30th - 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm

Non-profits...what are they? How do they run? What is their value to the community? What does it really mean to be a volunteer? This session will introduce participants to the Valley's health and human service community and the role of an effective board member.

#### SESSION 7) INCLUSION AND BELONGING - Thursday, November 6th - 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm

Inclusion and belonging relate to the actions taken to establish awareness and transform mindsets, behaviors, and practices to create and sustain a diverse, equitable and inclusive culture. In this session you will learn how to power-up your self-awareness and capitalize on the experiences and ideas of others to increase productivity and achieve organizational and community goals.
